Monitoring Requirements Not Met for River Pines Public Utility District Annual Nitrate Sampling for 2016

Our water system failed to monitor as required for drinking water standards during the past year and, therefore, was in violation of the regulations. Even though this failure was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what you should do, what happened, and what we did to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the calendar year 2016, we did not monitor Well 06R (PS Code: 0310006-009) for Nitrate and therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

- There is nothing you need to do at this time.
- The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how many samples we are required to take and how often, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be)taken.

What happened? What is being done?

We have been directed by the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water to collect a nitrate sample from Well 06R in 2017 and we plan to collect the sample before March 31, 2017. We will ensure annual nitrate sampling in the

future. We will notify you water produced by the well were to not meet the nitrate standard.

- BUSINESS PROPERTY OWNERS, MANAGERS, OR OPERATORS: Must notify employees of businesses located on the property.
