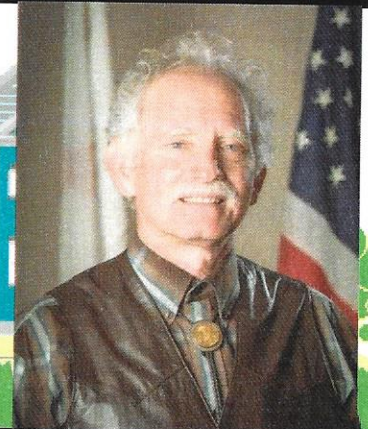

- Yard Trimmings & Green Waste (pine needles, branches, brushes)
- Tires- Only **9** at a time (will accept up to 180 total for cleanup)
- Mattresses (clean)

Non-recyclables

- Carpeting
- Junk Furniture
- General Trash
- Mattresses (dirty)

**NOT
ACCEPTED:**

- All light bulbs/tubes
- Dirt, construction or demolition rubble
- Hazardous wastes (paint, motor oil, batteries, etc)
- Propane Tanks / Gas Cylinders
- Medical Waste
