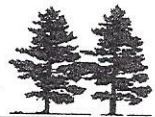

ANNEXATION AMADOR COUNTY
LAFCO AB-8 AGREEMENT

Whereas an application by River Pines PUD (district) has been properly submitted to LAFCO for annexation of 4 parcels and one portion of a parcel in Amador County for the purpose of annexing properties into the boundaries of the district that are currently receiving water service from the district; and


Whereas, Revenue and Taxation Code 99.01 provides that when a jurisdictional change (e.g. annexation) will result in a special district providing one or more services (e.g. water), the district may adopt a resolution accepting the share of property tax increment for the annexation parcel; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:
